When you visit Cable Bay we want you to enjoy complete peace of mind, we are pleased to share with you our COVID-19 Vaccination Policy and health and safety procedures

In line with the government guidelines you'll need a valid vaccine pass to visit Cable Bay. You'll also need to scan our QR code prior to entering our facility and carry with you your photo identification.

- All Cable Bay employees are fully vaccinated and are receiving regular training on the new standards regarding COVID-19 protocols. Every member of our team must strictly comply with the protective measures as recommended by the ministry of health. The measures include hand hygiene, wearing masks if mandated and social distancing. Team members will be asked to stay home and seek medical attention if they, or someone in their household, has any COVID-19 symptoms.
- When you arrive at Cable Bay, a member of our team will welcome you, sensitively communicating all of our new hygiene and health and safety measures so you can move seamlessly around our facility, knowing that you're being looked after with the greatest care.
- Hand sanitiser will be available in key places including; entry reception, cellar door, dining areas and bar.
- We have increased the frequency of cleaning and sanitising to once per hour. This applies to all public spaces with an emphasis on deep cleaning of frequent contact surfaces. These areas include, but are not limited to: the reception counter, payment machines, door handles, bathrooms and seating areas with dining, bar areas and menus being deep cleaned after each use.
- Our facility will be arranged to observe appropriate social distancing and we will continue to comply with any mandated occupancy limits.
